TRANSPORT :

Participants are responsible for their own transportation from the airport to the hotel and from the hotel to the airport.

Judo Canada apologize for the distance between the hotel and the venue, Due to a situation outside of our control, a bus will be offered both days (Saturday and Sunday) from the hotel to the tournament venue and back. The transport is free and will be posted at the hotel.

Note that the parking is very limited at the « Complexe Gadbois » due to construction in the area.

Sélection :

The HPD (High Performance Director) will announce the selections on **November 15th, 2016**.

Eligibility :

Athletes will be selected and invited to compete by the High Performance Director – Judo Canada.

Athletes must compete for the provincial association of which they are a member in good standing and affiliated.

All members and coaches MUST complete the CCES online module for Anti-Doping during the past twelve (12) months at time of event. If you completed it last year for the Elite 8 Nationals, you will have to redo the module for the 2017 Elite Invitational National Championships.

All participants must present a picture ID with their accreditation at weigh-in.

Only Canadian Citizens and Permanent Residents are allowed to participate in this tournament.

Registration:

Those that are invited to participate in the Championship must register online no later than December 2nd, 2016, 23:59 Eastern Time.

*If you are a late substitute and we have selected you, we will adjust the deadlines, ALTHOUGH you must absolutely follow the CCES module.

The registration website link will be provided with the invitation to participate in the 2017 Elite Invitational Judo Championship. Along with the registration link, education awareness modules (eg : CCES module) will also be provided to ensure athletes / coaches compliance.

Each participant in the National Championship is subject to a doping control by the Canadian Centre for Ethics in Sport (CCES) on a random basis in accordance with the Canadian Anti-Doping Program (CADP). To avoid an inadvertent positive test and the consequences of an anti-doping rule violation, athletes are encouraged to take the following steps:

Be familiar with: www.cces.ca/athletezone

- Check with DRO Global (www.globaldro.com) to determine if any prescription or over-the-counter medications or treatments that are banned by the WADA Prohibited List.
- Review medical exceptions requirements (www.cces.ca/medical) if you require the use of a banned medication for a legitimate medical reason.
- Do not use supplements, or take precautions prior to doing so. Supplement products cannot be verified by the CCES or in the Global DRO. A lack of industry and government regulation makes it impossible to confirm their ingredients. Read more at: www.cces.ca/suppléments

Competition Rules :

The IJF tournament format with quarter final repechage will be used for the Cader (U18) and direct elimination for the 18 and over division (senior). Please note that the two (2) victory condition to obtain points from Judo Canada will exceptionally be changed to one (1) victory in the senior division.

For weight divisions with five (5) or less competitors: Round Robin format will be used.

Tournament regulations as per Judo Canada's Tournament Standards and Sanction manual – 2016-2017 unless specified in this document.

All issues / cases(s) that are unexpected or deemed exceptional circumstances will be solved by decisions taken by the Judo Canada Sport Committee in cooperation with the Organizing Committee.

Medal Ceremony :

Medal winners must attend the medal ceremony in their white judogi or an official provincial tracksuit. Medal winners that refuse to participate in the ceremony will be removed from the result list and will not place (Carding points may be removed)

No promotion articles are authorized to be used / displayed (flags, T-shirt or similar items).

Damages:

No use of bleeding dyes on the body or hair of competitors is allowed. In cases such use is undetected and damage results to the equipment of the opponent, or tatami, the competitor will be disqualified and the Provincial or Territorial Association of which that individual is a member will be charged for the damage.

Insurance:

Judo Canada (or any of its officials or members) will not be liable or responsible for any personal injury nor for any loss or damage to any property out of participations and travelling in connection with these championships.

2. Athletes, who are not members of the National Team or participants in the National Championships, may attend the National Training Camp if they are members in good standing with their Provincial and Territorial Association and have :

3. A minimum of 3rd Kyu and have paid the registration fee for the training camp.

4. Everyone (including officials) is responsible for their accommodations.

5. One responsible person (trainer, manager) is required for a ratio of ten (10) underage athletes.

6. Training sessions will be conducted by Judo Canada designated Coaches.

7. There is the possibility that the training sessions may be divided by categories, depending on the number of registration. The schedule will be produced once the numbers of participants are known. Every participant is assured of two (2) training sessions per day
